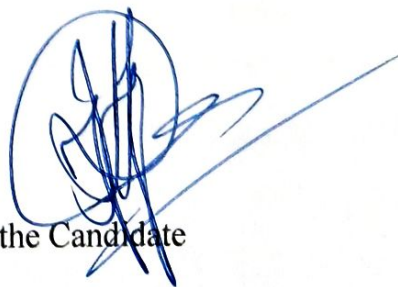

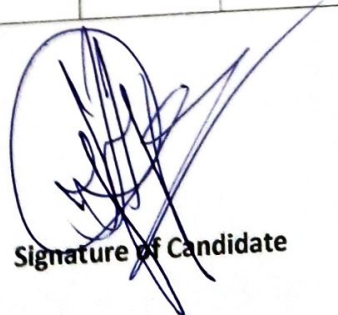

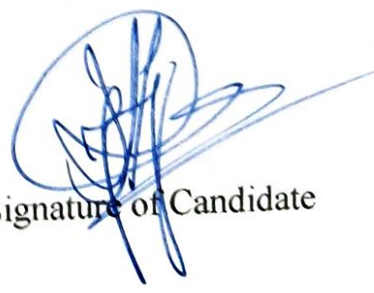

Revenue spending gets lion's share of ₹14K-cr Mizoram budget

'No New Tax Proposals'
By Nandakumar Thoma

Assam Finance Minister on Monday presented a ₹14,000 crore state budget for the 2022-23 financial year, with revenue expenditure getting the lion's share of it. He also tabled the supplementary demand for grants for the current financial year (2022-21) amounting to ₹1,200 crore with the budget.

"The budget has no new proposals for taxes and no increase in the existing tax rates. It is neither a deficit bud-



Chief Minister Zoramthanga said it is neither a deficit budget nor a surplus one.

get nor a surplus one," Zoramthanga, who also broke the revenue portfolio, said.

Saying that the Covid-19 pandemic adversely affected the economy, he said the state government is fighting for survival and so it has not taken up development activities in a big way.

Out of the ₹14,000 crore

₹14,000 crore has been earmarked for revenue expenditure (establishment costs) which is a whopping 78.10% of the total budgetary allocation, while a meagre ₹3,110 crore has been allotted for capital expenditure development activities. The latter accounts for 22.90% of the total budget.

Zoramthanga said the decrease in the earmarked capital expenditure is due to the paucity of ₹1,000 crore, which was allocated under PM Aardr NRE during the current financial year.

He said while the state government is expecting at least ₹300 crore under the Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI) ₹300

crore has been allocated in the budget due to lack of any concrete indication from the Centre. He further said the state government did not get more than ₹3,000 crore, which it had expected to receive from the Centre, because of pandemic-induced financial problems. "I have allocated ₹100 crore for the healthcare activities, out of which ₹10 crore would be raised from the state treasury," he said.

The chief minister has allocated ₹100 crore under the state government's flagship programme - Social Economic Development - Policy (SEDP), out of which ₹300 crore has been earmarked for a family-oriented scheme under the policy.
